
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 29-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Beginning July 1, 2004, and for each fiscal year
4 thereafter, the department of education may set aside \$100,000
5 of federal impact aid moneys received pursuant to this section
6 to:

7 (1) Establish and fund a permanent, full-time military
8 liaison position within the department of education;
9 [and]

10 (2) Establish and fund a permanent, full-time assistant
11 military liaison position within the department of
12 education; and

13 (3) Fund the joint venture education program to facilitate
14 interaction between the military community and the
15 department of education.

16 The military liaison [~~position~~] and assistant military
17 liaison positions established under [~~paragraph~~] paragraphs (1)
18 and (2) shall be exempt from chapter 76 but shall be eligible to



1 receive the benefits of any state or federal employee benefit
2 program generally applicable to officers and employees of the
3 State."

4 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1404, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

6 "(b) Beginning July 1, 2004, and for each fiscal year
7 thereafter, the department of education may set aside \$100,000
8 of federal impact aid moneys received pursuant to this section
9 to:

10 (1) Establish and fund a permanent, full-time military
11 liaison position within the department of education;
12 [and]

13 (2) Establish and fund a permanent, full-time assistant
14 military liaison position within the department of
15 education; and

16 (3) Fund the joint venture education program to facilitate
17 interaction between the military community and the
18 department of education.

19 The military liaison [~~position~~] and assistant military
