# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§6E-        Archaeological permit special account.   (a)

5 There shall be a special account within the Hawaii historic  
6 preservation special fund to be known as the "archaeological  
7 permit special account".

8           (b) Moneys deposited into the special account shall first  
9 be used to cover the administrative and operational costs of  
10 managing the archaeological permit system.

11           (c) Moneys remaining after disbursement under subsection  
12 (b) shall be expended as provided in section 6E-16(b).

13           (d) The department shall adopt rules in accordance with  
14 chapter 91 for the purposes of this section."

15           SECTION 2. The board of land and natural resources is  
16 directed to amend any appropriate administrative rules, to  
17 increase archaeological permit fees from the current rate of \$50  
18 to no less than \$1,000, and to specify that the permit fees are

1 to be deposited into the archaeological permit special account  
2 established under section 6E- , Hawaii Revised Statutes.

3 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
