A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC ABSTRACT FEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 287-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The traffic violations bureaus of the district
- 4 courts, upon request, shall furnish any person a certified
- 5 abstract of the bureaus' record, if any, of any person relating
- 6 to all alleged moving violations and any convictions resulting
- 7 therefrom, arising from the operation of a motor vehicle and any
- 8 administrative license revocation pursuant to chapter 291E, part
- 9 III and chapter 286, part XIV, as it was in effect on or before
- 10 December 31, 2001. The traffic violations bureaus may collect a
- 11 fee, not to exceed [\$7,] \$10, of which [\$5] \$8 shall be
- 12 deposited into the general fund and \$2 shall be deposited into
- 13 the judiciary computer system special fund."
- 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
