BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-301, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[+] §103D-301 [+] Methods of source selection[-]; contract~~
4 requirements. (a) Unless otherwise authorized by law, all
5 contracts shall be awarded by competitive sealed bidding
6 pursuant to section 103D-302, except as provided in:

- 7 (1) Section 103D-303 (Competitive sealed proposals);
8 (2) Section 103D-304 (Professional services procurement);
9 (3) Section 103D-305 (Small purchases);
10 (4) Section 103D-306 (Sole source procurement); and
11 (5) Section 103D-307 (Emergency procurements).

12 **(b) Notwithstanding any other law, rule, or practice to**
13 **the contrary, for purposes of this chapter:**

- 14 **(1) A contract shall be deemed effective as of the notice**
15 **of the award;**
16 **(2) The solicitation, offer, bid, or proposal and the**
17 **notice of award shall constitute the entire contract**







