10 SECTION 4. Article XVI, Section 4, of the Constitution of
11 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:

12 "OATH OF OFFICE

13 Section 4. All eligible public officers, before entering
14 upon the duties of their respective offices, shall take and
15 subscribe to the following oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly
16 swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the
17 Constitution of the United States, and the Constitution of the
18 State of Hawaii, and that I will faithfully discharge my duties
19 as to the best of my ability." As used
20 in this section, "eligible public officers" means the governor,
21 the lieutenant governor, the members of both houses of the
22 legislature, [~~the members of the board of education,~~] the



1 members of the national guard, State or county employees who
2 possess police powers, district court judges, and all those
3 whose appointment requires the consent of the senate."

4 SECTION 5. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
5 be as follows:

6 "Shall the Board of Education be abolished?"

7 SECTION 6. Constitutional material to be repealed is
8 bracketed and stricken.

9 SECTION 7. This amendment shall take effect upon
10 compliance with Article XVII, Section 3, of the Constitution of
11 the State of Hawaii.
