
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELDERLY HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 356D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "Elder or elderly
3 households" to read as follows:


4 "Elder or elderly households" means households in which at
5 least one member is sixty-two years of age, the spouse or
6 partner has attained eighteen years of age, and the remaining
7 members have attained the age of [~~fifty-five~~] sixty-two years at
8 the time of application to the project."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
