## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARBORS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 200-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) No person shall moor a vessel in a state small boat  
4 harbor without:

5           (1) First obtaining a use permit from the department;

6           [and]

7           (2) Being the owner of the vessel ~~[-]~~; and

8           (3) Obtaining insurance that provides sufficient coverage  
9           for vessel removal, if the vessel runs aground or is  
10           otherwise stranded, or for damages done to harbor  
11           facilities; proof of coverage shall be displayed upon  
12           request by department officials.

13           The chairperson may adopt rules necessary to enforce this  
14           subsection."

15           SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
17 begun before its effective date.




1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
