
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for the
4 auditor to conduct a comprehensive management, financial, and
5 program audit of the department of education.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
7 auditor for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 2. The auditor shall submit a report to the
9 legislature of all findings and recommendations, including any
10 proposed legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the
11 convening of the regular session of 2011.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
