# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 27G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§27G-    Access Hawaii committee special fund. There is  
5 established in the state treasury the access Hawaii committee  
6 special fund, into which shall be deposited fees collected by  
7 the information and communication services division within the  
8 department of accounting and general services for the purpose of  
9 supporting the access Hawaii committee. Expenditures from the  
10 access Hawaii committee special fund shall be approved by the  
11 access Hawaii committee; provided that information on income and  
12 expenditures shall be subject to legislative review and  
13 oversight in each budget submittal from the department of  
14 accounting and general services."

15           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the access Hawaii  
16 committee special fund the sum of \$185,000 or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, for fiscal year 2010-2011 for the purposes of  
18 supporting the access Hawaii committee.



1           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the access Hawaii  
2 committee for the purposes of this Act.

3           SECTION 3.   New statutory material is underscored.

4           SECTION 4.   This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
