
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-239, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

3 "(g) Commercial driver's licenses shall expire as follows:

4 (1) An initial or renewed commercial driver's license with
5 a hazardous materials endorsement shall expire no
6 later than five years from its date of issuance,
7 except if the licensee is seventy-two years of age or
8 older. The expiration date of a commercial driver's
9 license with a hazardous materials endorsement shall
10 be the same expiration date as the hazardous materials
11 endorsement. If the licensee is seventy-two years of
12 age or older, the initial or renewed commercial
13 driver's license with a hazardous materials
14 endorsement shall not exceed two years~~[-]~~; and

15 (2) All other initial commercial driver's licenses shall
16 be valid for not [~~less~~] more than [~~a] two or six~~
17 ~~year]~~ an eight-year period, [~~beginning]~~ expiring on
18 the driver's birthday. All other renewed licenses
