
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REAL ESTATE LICENSEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the continual
2 evolution of the real estate industry requires that real estate
3 brokers and salespersons regularly update their knowledge of
4 changes to the real estate industry. The legislature further
5 finds that an increase in continuing education hours will
6 advance the level of professionalism in the real estate
7 industry.

8 The purpose of this Act is to increase professionalism
9 among real estate licensees by increasing the minimum required
10 continuing education hours for real estate brokers and
11 salespersons from ten hours to twenty hours in each two-year
12 licensing period.

13 SECTION 2. Section 467-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

15 "(a) Prior to the license renewal of a real estate broker or
16 real estate salesperson, the licensee shall provide the commission
17 with proof of having attended [~~ten~~] at least twenty hours of
18 continuing education or its equivalent as determined by the



1 commission during the two-year period preceding the application
2 for renewal. Failure to satisfy the continuing education
3 requirement by the license expiration date shall result in the
4 renewed license being automatically placed on an "inactive"
5 status."

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2011.
