
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Mililani and Waipio Gentry's thirty-seventh
2 representative district encompasses the new and expanding area
3 of Waipio Gentry and older areas of Mililani. Schools within
4 the thirty-seventh representative district have many issues,
5 including repair and maintenance, traffic congestion, and
6 facilities that are outdated and in need of restoration.

7 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
8 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
9 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
10 Hawaii for fiscal year 2010-2011:
