
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENIOR CENTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that senior centers
2 on our islands provide invaluable services to seniors by
3 promoting a host of social, educational, and cultural
4 opportunities and activities geared toward healthy lifestyles.

5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
6 the operations of certain senior centers so that they may
7 continue to enhance the quality of life for seniors in their
8 respective communities.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$682,000 or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
13 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to be distributed as follows:

15	(1) Lanakila multi-purpose senior center	\$337,000
16	(2) Kapahulu senior center	\$100,000
17	(3) Moiliili senior center	\$125,000

1 (4) Waikiki community center \$120,000

2 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
3 of health for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
