## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 :	SECTION 1.	The	legislature	recognizes	that	senior	centers

- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$682,000 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
- 12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 13 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
- 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to be distributed as follows:
- 15 (1) Lanakila multi-purpose senior center \$337,000
- 16 (2) Kapahulu senior center \$100,000
- 17 (3) Moiliili senior center \$125,000

1 (4) Waikiki community center

\$120,000

- 2 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 3 of health for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
