
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a), this chapter shall
4 not apply to contracts made by any regional system board of the
5 Hawaii health systems corporation[-], the University of Hawaii,
6 or the board of regents of the University of Hawaii."

7 SECTION 2. Section 304A-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

9 "(b) The board of regents shall develop internal policies
10 and procedures for the procurement of goods, services, and
11 construction, consistent with the goals of public accountability
12 and public procurement practices, but without being subject to
13 chapter 103D. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
14 chapter 103D shall not apply to any actions or activities
15 undertaken, conducted, or performed under authority of the board
16 of regents or the university. Where possible, however, the
17 board is encouraged to use the provisions of chapter 103D as
18 guidelines; provided that in using one or more provisions of



1 chapter 103D as guidelines, neither the board nor the university
2 shall be:

3 (1) Deemed to have waived in any way the exemption from
4 the requirements and applicability of chapter 103D
5 granted in this section to the board and the
6 university; or

7 (2) Subject to any of the provisions or requirements of
8 chapter 103D."


9 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
11 begun, before its effective date.

12 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



14 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
