
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsections (a), (b), and (c) to read:

4 "(a) There is created a works of art special fund, into
5 which shall be transferred [~~one~~] two per cent of all state fund
6 appropriations for capital improvements designated for the
7 construction cost element; provided that this transfer shall
8 apply only to capital improvement appropriations that are
9 designated for the construction or renovation of state
10 buildings. The [~~one~~] two per cent transfer requirement shall
11 not apply to appropriations from the passenger facility charge
12 special fund established by section 261-5.5 and the rental motor
13 vehicle customer facility charge special fund established under
14 section 261-5.6.

15 (b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely for
16 the following purposes:

17 (1) Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,

18 including any consultant or staff services required to



- 1 carry out the art in public places and relocatable
2 works of art programs;
- 3 (2) Site modifications, display, and interpretive work
4 necessary for the exhibition of works of art;
- 5 (3) Upkeep services, including maintenance, repair, and
6 restoration of works of art;
- 7 (4) Storing and transporting works of art~~[]~~; and
8 (5) Costs incurred for capital improvement projects, the
9 purchase of facilities, and for the repair and
10 maintenance of facilities dedicated to culture and the
11 arts; provided that:
- 12 (A) Up to fifty per cent of the moneys in the works
13 of art special fund may be used for this purpose;
14 and
- 15 (B) The two per cent requirement as provided in this
16 section shall not apply to the capital
17 improvement projects in this paragraph.
- 18 (c) The ~~[one]~~ two per cent amount, which is included in
19 all capital improvement appropriations, shall be calculated at
20 the time the appropriation bills are signed into law. The
21 moneys shall be transferred into the works of art special fund
22 upon availability of moneys from the appropriations. Each



1 agency receiving capital improvement appropriations shall
2 calculate the [~~one~~] two per cent amount and transfer the moneys
3 into the works of art special fund."

4 2. By amending subsections (e) and (f) to read:

5 "(e) The comptroller shall:

6 (1) Provide each agency receiving capital improvement
7 appropriations with information regarding items that
8 shall be included and excluded from the [~~one~~] two per
9 cent amount;

10 (2) Ensure that each agency calculates its [~~one~~] two per
11 cent amount correctly; and

12 (3) Ensure that each agency transfers the correct amount
13 to the works of art special fund in a timely manner.

14 (f) The comptroller and the executive director shall track
15 amounts due from each agency under the [~~one~~] two per cent
16 transfer requirement as provided in this section."

17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.



Report Title:

Works of Art Special Fund

Description:

Increases the amount of state fund appropriations for capital improvement construction costs earmarked for the Works of Art Special Fund (Special Fund) from one to two percent. Allows 50 percent of the Special Fund to be used for capital improvement projects, the purchase of facilities, and repair and maintenance of facilities dedicated to culture and the arts. (HB601 HD1)
