
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIABILITY OF ROOSTER OWNERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 142, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 "§142- Liability of rooster owner; penalty. If any
4 rooster escapes or is removed from its owner's property while
5 wearing a sharp object on its leg, such as a blade or gaff, the
6 owner shall be subject to the penalty imposed under section 142-
7 12."

8 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
10 begun, before its effective date.
11 and to read as follows:

12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
