
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 444-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3 "(b) Of the board members:
4 (1) Ten shall be contractors who have been actively
5 engaged in the contracting business for a period of
6 not less than five years preceding the date of their
7 appointment;
8 (2) Five shall be general engineering or building
9 contractors, five shall be specialty contractors, and
10 three shall be noncontractors[-];
11 (3) At least three shall be appointed from a list of
12 nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of
13 representatives; and
14 (4) At least three shall be appointed from a list of
15 nominees submitted by the president of the senate.



1 No member shall receive any compensation for the member's
2 services, but each shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling
3 expenses incurred in the performance of duties."

4 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to the contractors license
5 board upon its next vacancy.

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
