HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A MANAGEMENT AND FINANCIAL AUDIT OF THE HAWAII AIR NATIONAL GUARD.

1 WHEREAS, the Hawaii National Guard was established on January 27, 1893, to assist authorities in providing for the 2 safety, welfare, and defense of the people of Hawaii; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Hawaii National Guard comprises the Hawaii Air 5 National Guard (HIANG) and Hawaii Army National Guard; and 6 7 WHEREAS, HIANG has a mission of providing organized, 8 9 trained units to protect Hawaii's citizens and property, preserve peace, and ensure public safety in response to natural 10 or human-caused disasters; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, HIANG also has a federal mission to provide operationally-ready combat units, combat support units, and 14 qualified personnel for active duty in the United States Air 15 Force in times of war, national emergency, or operational 16 contingency; and 17 18 WHEREAS, HIANG, commanded by Major General Darryll D.M. 19 Wong, is composed of the headquarters of HIANG, 154th Wing, 109th 20 Air Operations Group, and 201st Combat Communications Group, 21 units of which are located on the islands of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, 22 23 and Hawaii; and 24 WHEREAS, concerns regarding the reliability of the HIANG 25 senior officer and command selection process have been raised; 26 27 and 28 WHEREAS, the critical role HIANG plays in responding to 29 natural and man-made disasters, as well as its strategic 30 31 importance to our national security, requires that the selection process used to select senior officers (O-6 and above) and 32
