17 WHEREAS, In 2005, the Legislature created the High
18 Technology Innovation Corporation to assist in the
19 diversification the State's economy by facilitating the growth
20 and development of the commercial high technology industry; and

22 WHEREAS, the High Technology Innovation Corporation is
23 concerned with the health of Hawaii's natural environment and is
24 dedicated to creating designs and projects that increase
25 sustainability and use energy saving techniques; and

27 WHEREAS, the State supports innovative persons, projects
28 and companies that incorporate energy-saving techniques, and the
29 State recognizes that this is crucial to sustaining and
30 promoting growth within Hawaii's commercial high technology
31 industry sector and is beneficial to the state economy,

34 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
35 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
36 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that the High Technology
37 Innovation Corporation is requested to establish an energy
38 innovation award to be given to an applicant that presents
39 patentable technologies that create significant energy savings


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the

 4 selection of award winners, and prize amounts; and



 8 the High Technology Innovation Corporation.




