## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A STUDY OF MORNING TRAFFIC CONGESTION ON THE MEHEULA  
PARKWAY GOING ONTO THE H2 FREEWAY FROM MILILANI MAUKA.

1           WHEREAS, residents of central Oahu in Mililani Mauka have  
2 complained for years about the morning rush hour traffic  
3 congestion on the Meheula Parkway going onto the H2 Freeway  
4 southbound to town; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, the morning congestion poses a risk of serious  
7 accidents and causes motorists to lose valuable time in their  
8 morning commute to work due to having only a single lane to  
9 enter the H2 Freeway southbound; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, the congestion is further exacerbated by the  
12 traffic from Mililani Town making a left turn from Meheula  
13 Parkway to go northbound towards Wahiawa on the H2 Freeway; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has jurisdiction  
16 over state highways such as the H2 Freeway; and  
17

18           WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu has jurisdiction  
19 over county highways such as the Meheula Parkway; and  
20

21           WHEREAS, the morning peak hour traffic congestion problem  
22 needs to be remedied so that commute time delays and safety  
23 concerns are addressed to the satisfaction of the community;  
24 now, therefore,  
25

26           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
27 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
28 of 2010, that the Department of Transportation is requested to  
29 conduct a study in conjunction with the Honolulu Department of  
30 Transportation Services of morning traffic congestion on the  
31 Meheula Parkway, particularly for Mililani Mauka residents  
32 heading to H2 Freeway southbound; and

34           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study identify the causes  
35 of the traffic congestion and the solutions to ease the traffic  
36 congestion, including the use of "no left turn" signs during



1 morning peak traffic from Meheula Parkway going northbound to  
2 Wahiawa; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of  
5 Transportation schedule and hold community informational  
6 briefings during the course of the study; and

7

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of  
9 Transportation report its findings and recommendations to the  
10 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
11 the Regular Session of 2011; and

12

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
14 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Transportation and  
15 the Director of the Department of Transportation Services of the  
16 City and County of Honolulu.
