
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Hawaii Constitution.
- 4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
5 \$40,000,000 in general funds and \$80,000,000 in federal funds
6 for an emergency appropriation for fiscal year 2009-2010 for
7 health care payments (HMS 401) to address a funding shortfall in
8 the Medicaid program.
- 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$40,000,000 or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for
12 health care payments (HMS 401) to address the funding shortfall
13 in the Medicaid program.
- 14 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of federal Medicaid
15 funds the sum of \$80,000,000 or so much thereof as may be
16 necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for health care payments
17 (HMS 401) as a federal match for state funds.



1 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
2 department of human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
