A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWELFTH SENATE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010.

5 1. To be expended by the department of education:

6 A. Central middle school, Oahu

7 Design and construction to enclose the pedestrian
8 overpass that connects the mauka and makai campuses.

20 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.


