A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 78, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§78- Exemption from furloughs and reduction in force.

5 All permanent and temporary public employees whose positions are
6 funded in full or in part by funds other than the general fund
7 of the State of Hawaii, including but not limited to special
8 funds, shall be exempt from furloughs and reductions in force.

9 For purposes of this section, "furlough" means the
10 placement of an employee in a temporary non-duty, non-pay status
11 due to non-disciplinary reasons."

12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
