A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 223, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, section
2 2, is amended by amending subsection (c) and (d) to read as
3 follows:

4 "(c) The board of land and natural resources shall provide
5 each lessee or permittee with proposed new lease terms and rates
6 within three months of the effective date of this Act and shall
7 negotiate final terms of each lease within four months of the
8 effective date of this Act. The lessee or permittee shall have
9 thirty days following the final notification to the lessee or
10 permittee by the board of new lease terms, to agree to and sign
11 the renegotiated lease, or the lease or permit shall expire on
12 December 31, 2008, and the recreation-residence use lease shall
13 be ~~[auctioned]~~ offered to the public through a lottery system
14 administered by the board.

15 (d) Any recreation-residence use lease for a cabin that is
16 vacant and owned by the State on the effective date of this Act
17 or that expires on December 31, 2008, pursuant to subsection
18 (c), shall be ~~[auctioned]~~ offered to the public through a




1 lottery system administered by the board [~~pursuant to section~~
2 ~~171-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes~~]; provided that the board of
3 land and natural resources shall first provide bona fide full-
4 time residents of a county in the state with a population of
5 less than 100,000 with the opportunity to obtain any such lease
6 by [~~auction.~~] lottery. If any leases remain after such an
7 [~~auction,~~] lottery, the board may offer remaining available
8 leases [~~at auction~~] by lottery to [~~bidders~~] individuals who are
9 bona fide full-time residents of the State of Hawaii, and then
10 [~~at auction~~] to nonresidents of the State."

11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
