# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-102.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:

3 "(f) A provisional licensee may be issued a driver's  
4 license in accordance with this chapter if the provisional  
5 licensee:

6 (1) Has satisfactorily held a provisional license for at  
7 least six months[+] or until the age of eighteen,  
8 whichever comes first;

9 (2) Has no pending proceeding that might result in the  
10 suspension or revocation of the license;

11 (3) Is at least seventeen years of age; and

12 (4) Has satisfactorily complied with all requirements of  
13 this chapter."

14 SECTION 2. Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is amended  
15 by amending section 15 to read as follows:

16 "SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on January 9,

4 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
6 begun before its effective date.

7 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Driver Licensing; Provisional License

**Description:**

Makes the statutory requirements for provisional driver's licenses for persons under the age of eighteen permanent. Permits a provisional licensee to receive a driver's license upon turning eighteen years of age. (SB2449 HD1)
