S.B. NO. 2452

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-406, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) The department [~~may~~] shall provide suitable
4 transportation to and from school and for educational field
5 trips for all children in grades kindergarten to twelve and in
6 special education classes. The department shall adopt such
7 policy, procedure, and program as it deems necessary to provide
8 suitable transportation. In formulating the policy, procedure,
9 and program, the department shall consider the school district;
10 the school attendance area in which a school child normally
11 resides; the distance the school child lives from the school;
12 the availability of public carriers or other means of
13 transportation; the frequency, regularity, and availability of
14 public transportation; and the grade level, physical handicap,
15 or special learning disability of a school child, and it may
16 also consider such conditions and circumstances unique or
17 peculiar to a county or area."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
