A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 328L-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "\$328L-4 Use of funds appropriated to the department. The
4 department, immediately upon receipt of the moneys appropriated
5 pursuant to section 328L-2(b)(2) shall:

6 (1) Transfer up to ten per cent of the total moneys
7 received by the State from tobacco settlement moneys
8 to the department of human services for the children's
9 health insurance program; and

10 (2) Expend the remainder of the moneys received by the
11 department for health promotion and disease prevention
12 programs, including but not limited to, maternal child
13 health and child development programs, promotion of
14 healthy lifestyles (including fitness, nutrition, and
15 tobacco control), and prevention oriented public
16 health programs.

1	[For purposes of paragraph (2), the director shall convene
2	an advisory group that shall be separate from the tobacco
3	prevention and control advisory board, to strategically plan the
4	development and implementation of preventive systems to achieve
5	measurable outcomes and to make recommendations for the
6	expenditure of these moneys. The advisory group shall be
7	composed of nine members with expertise in the programs under
8	paragraph (2), and shall be selected at the discretion of the
9	director.]"
10	SECTION 2. Section 328L-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	"§328L-5 Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund.
13	(a) There is established the Hawaii tobacco prevention and
14	control trust fund as a separate fund of a nonprofit entity
15	having a board of directors and qualifying under section
16	501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, into
17	which shall be deposited moneys received as provided under
18 .	section 328L-2(b)(3). The director of health with the
19	concurrence of the governor, shall select, in accordance with
20	law, the entity based upon the proven record of accomplishment
21	of the entity in administering a similar trust fund.



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1 (b) Notwithstanding that the Hawaii tobacco prevention and 2 control trust fund is established within a private entity, the 3 department of budget and finance shall have oversight authority over the fund and may make periodic financial audits of the 4 5 fund; provided that the director of finance may contract with a 6 certified public accountancy firm for this purpose. The 7 director of health with the concurrence of the governor in their 8 sole discretion may rescind the selection of the entity. If the 9 selection of the entity [is] rescinded, moneys in the trust fund 10 shall revert back to the State and shall be deemed to be trust 11 moneys.

12 The entity selected under subsection (a), for each (C) 13 fiscal year, may expend, as specified by the tobacco prevention 14 and control advisory board pursuant to section 328L-6, up to 15 fifty per cent of the total market value of the Hawaii tobacco 16 prevention and control trust fund on the preceding June 30, for tobacco prevention and control, including but not limited to, 17 18 reducing cigarette smoking and tobacco use among youth and 19 adults through education and enforcement activities, and 20 controlling and preventing chronic diseases where tobacco is a 21 risk factor. The entity selected under subsection (a) may make recommendations to the tobacco prevention and control advisory 22



board as to funding approval for activities pursuant to this
 subsection.

3 (d) The Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund 4 may receive appropriations, contributions, grants, endowments, 5 or gifts in cash or otherwise from any source, including the 6 State, corporations or other businesses, foundations, 7 government, individuals, and other interested parties; provided 8 that any appropriations made by the State shall not supplant or 9 diminish the funding of existing tobacco prevention and control 10 programs or any health related programs funded in whole or in 11 part by the State. 12 The assets of the Hawaii tobacco prevention and (e) 13 control trust fund shall consist of: 14 (1)Moneys appropriated under section 328L-2(b)(3); 15 (2) Moneys appropriated to the Hawaii tobacco prevention 16 and control trust fund by the state, county, or 17 federal government; 18 (3) Private contributions of cash or property; and 19 (4)Income and capital gains earned by the trust fund. 20 (f) The aggregate principal sum deposited in the Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund shall be invested by 21 22 the entity selected under subsection (a) in a manner intended to 2010-0568 SB SMA.doc

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1 maximize the rate of return on investment of the trust fund 2 consistent with the objective of preserving the trust fund's 3 principal. 4 (g) The entity selected under subsection (a), for each 5 fiscal year, shall submit a report to the legislature and to the tobacco prevention and control advisory board created under 6 7 section 328L-6. The report shall include: 8 Amounts received from appropriations, contributions, (1)9 grants, endowments, and gifts from any sources and in 10 any form; 11 (2) Income and capital gains earned by the fund; 12 Investments of fund moneys and outcomes of each (3) 13 investment; and 14 Expenditures of fund moneys pursuant to subsection (c) (4) 15 and outcomes achieved by each expenditure as measured 16 by criteria developed by the tobacco prevention and 17 control advisory board pursuant to section 328L-6. 18 $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$ (h) If the entity selected under subsection (a) is 19 dissolved, the director of health, with the concurrence of the 20 governor, shall select a successor entity. If the Hawaii 21 tobacco prevention and control trust fund is terminated, the



1	moneys remaining in the trust fund shall revert back to the
2	State and shall be deemed to be trust moneys.
3	[(h)] <u>(i)</u> The administration of the Hawaii tobacco
4	prevention and control trust fund shall be advised by the
5.	tobacco prevention and control advisory board created under
6	section 328L-6."
7	SECTION 3. Section 328L-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9.	"[[]§328L-6[]] Tobacco prevention and control advisory
10	board. (a) There is established a tobacco prevention and
11	control advisory board under the department for administrative
12	purposes.
13	(b) The tobacco prevention and control advisory board
14	shall consist of members who are involved in tobacco prevention
15	and control. Membership of the board shall be as follows:
16	[(1) One member of the governor's staff, appointed by the
17	governor;
18	(2)] (1) One member to be appointed by the governor from a
19	list of two names submitted by the president of the
20	senate;



(1)	Be appointed or designated, as applicable, without
	regard to section 26-34;
(2)	Serve without compensation; and
(3)	Serve for a term of three years.
(d)	The tobacco prevention and control advisory board, in

plan for	tobacco prevention and control, including:
(1)	Developing and implementing effective and cost
	efficient programs, including health promotion and
	disease prevention;

9 ⁻	SECTION 4. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is
10	amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
11	"SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009,
12	and shall be repealed on June 30, 2015; provided that [section]
13	sections 328L-2, 328L-3, and 328L-4 shall be reenacted in the
14	form in which $[it]$ they read on the day before the effective
15	date of Act 264, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007[-]; provided
16	further that the amendments made to section 328L-4, Hawaii
17	Revised Statutes, by section 1 of Act , Session Laws of
18	Hawaii 2010, shall not be repealed when that section is
19	reenacted on June 30, 2015."
20	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
