
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING
AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that the
2 board of directors of the Hawaii public housing authority is
3 able to perform its duties in a timely and efficient manner by
4 reducing from seven to six members the number of board members
5 required to constitute quorum.

6 SECTION 2. Section 356D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

8 "(c) [~~Seven~~] Six members shall constitute a quorum, whose
9 affirmative vote shall be necessary for all actions by the
10 authority. The members shall receive no compensation for
11 services, but shall be entitled to necessary expenses, including
12 travel expenses, incurred in the performance of their duties."

13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
