## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$55,968,077, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year  
5 2010-2011, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for  
6 the fifteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Aiea elementary school

8 A. Design and construction of campus-  
9 wide electrical upgrades.

11 2. Aliamanu elementary school

12 A. Plans, design, and construction of  
13 administration building for  
14 clerical, administrative, and  
15 support staff.

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
5 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
6 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
7 of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

8 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
9 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
10 following agencies for the purposes of this Act:

- 11 (1) The department of education, in the case of items 1 to  
12 15; and
- 13 (2) The department of transportation, in the case of  
14 items 16 and 17.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
