A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$39,750,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2010-2011
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the first
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Laupahoehoe valley access road, Hawaii
8 Plans, design, and construction for a
9 new access road from Laupahoehoe valley
10 to Belt highway 19.

 22 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



1 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
2 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
3 unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 8. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
5 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
6 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
7 follows:

- 8 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 and 2 shall be
9 expended by the department of transportation;
- 10 (2) The sums appropriated in items 3 and 4 shall be
11 expended by the county of Hawaii;
- 12 (3) The sums appropriated in item 5 shall be expended by
13 the department of accounting and general services;
- 14 (4) The sums appropriated in item 6 and 7 shall be
15 expended by the department of agriculture;
- 16 (5) The sums appropriated in item 8 shall be expended by
17 the department of Hawaiian home lands;
- 18 (6) The sums appropriated in items 9 through 12 shall be
19 expended by the department of water supply, county of
20 Hawaii; and
- 21 (7) The sums appropriated in item 13 shall be expended by
22 the department of education.



1 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
