A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$15,939,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2010-2011, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the twenty-fourth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. **Aikahi elementary school, Oahu**

8 A. Upgrade telephone system, repair
9 the roof of building D, and
10 renovate cafeteria and bathrooms.

13 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 16 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 17 of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 19 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 20 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
 21 follows:



- 1 (1) For items 1 through 14, the expending agency shall be
2 the department of education;
- 3 (2) For item 15, the expending agency shall be the
4 department of human services;
- 5 (3) For item 16, the expending agency shall be the
6 department of health;
- 7 (4) For item 17, the expending agency shall be the
8 department of land and natural resources; and
- 9 (5) For item 18, the expending agency shall be the
10 department of transportation.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
