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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$39,227,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010  
5 for capital improvement projects for the nineteenth senatorial  
6 district, as follows:

7 1. Barbers point elementary school

8 A. Air conditioning for entire  
9 school.

11 Construction 2,700,000

14 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
 15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are  
 17 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
 18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2011, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 20 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
 21 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;  
 22 provided that:



1           (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 8 shall be  
2           expended by the department of education; and

3           (2) The sums appropriated in items 9 and 10 shall be  
4           expended by the department of transportation.

5           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
