# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ESCAPE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 710-1021, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§710-1021 Escape in the second degree.** (1) A person  
4 commits the offense of escape in the second degree if [~~the~~]:

5           (a) The person intentionally escapes from a correctional  
6           or detention facility or from custody [~~+~~]; or

7           (b) The person knowingly fails to appear in person at a  
8           correctional facility or detention facility by the  
9           time and date ordered by a court of competent  
10           jurisdiction, for the service of a term of custody or  
11           confinement ordered by the court for a conviction of a  
12           felony.

13           (2) Escape in the second degree is a class C felony."

14           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

**Report Title:**

Correctional Facility; Escape

**Description:**

Expands the charge of escape in the second degree to persons who fail to present themselves to a correctional or detention facility at the date and time as ordered by the court for service of a term of custody or confinement for a felony conviction. Effective July 1, 2050. (SD1)
