# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARINE LIFE CONSERVATION DISTRICTS.


**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 190-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:  
3           "§190-4 Permits. The department of land and natural  
4 resources may, in any conservation district, prohibit the taking  
5 of marine life or the engaging in activities prohibited by this  
6 chapter and rules adopted thereunder, except by permit issued by  
7 it for scientific, education, or other public purposes on such  
8 terms and conditions deemed necessary to minimize any adverse  
9 effect within the conservation district[-]; provided that the  
10 department shall provide written notice of any change in permit  
11 conditions ninety calendar days prior to the effective date of  
12 the change, except, as determined by the department, when an  
13 immediate change in permit conditions is necessary to protect or  
14 preserve the conservation district. The department may revoke  
15 any permit for any infraction of the terms and conditions of the  
16 permit. Any person whose permit has been revoked shall not be  
17 eligible to apply for another permit until the expiration of one  
18 year from the date of revocation."



- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.  
3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
