
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FIFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010:

5 1. To be expended by the department of accounting
6 and general services:

7 A. Roosevelt high school, Oahu
8 Cliff stabilization - below F bldg.
9 Structural bolstering to permanently
10 stabilize a fractured and cracked cliff
11 face that supports school buildings.
