
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
4 grant to the department of the prosecuting attorney of the city
5 and county of Honolulu for the career criminal prosecution unit,
6 including the hiring of necessary staff.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
10 grant to the department of the prosecuting attorney of the city
11 and county of Honolulu for the victim witness assistance
12 program, including the hiring of necessary staff.

13 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated in sections 1 and 2 shall
14 be expended by the city and county of Honolulu for the purposes
15 of this Act.

16 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a



1 grant to the department of the prosecuting attorney of the
2 county of Maui for the career criminal prosecution unit,
3 including the hiring of necessary staff.

4 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
7 grant to the department of the prosecuting attorney of the
8 county of Maui for the victim witness assistance program,
9 including the hiring of necessary staff.

10 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated in sections 4 and 5 shall
11 be expended by the county of Maui for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
15 grant to the office of the prosecuting attorney of the county of
16 Kauai for the career criminal prosecution unit, including the
17 hiring of necessary staff.

18 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
21 grant to the office of the prosecuting attorney of the county of



1 Kauai for the victim witness assistance program, including the
2 hiring of necessary staff.

3 SECTION 9. The sums appropriated in sections 7 and 8 shall
4 be expended by the county of Kauai for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
8 grant to the office of the prosecuting attorney of the county of
9 Hawaii for the career criminal prosecution unit, including the
10 hiring of necessary staff.

11 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for a
14 grant to the office of the prosecuting attorney of the county of
15 Hawaii for the victim witness assistance program, including the
16 hiring of necessary staff.

17 SECTION 12. The sums appropriated in sections 10 and 11
18 shall be expended by the county of Hawaii for the purposes of
19 this Act.

20 SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2046.
