## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOME OCCUPATIONS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
3 read as follows:

4           "§46- Home occupation. (a) Notwithstanding any law to  
5 the contrary, no county ordinance regulating home occupations  
6 shall prohibit the owner of a home occupation from:

7           (1) Employing less than three employees;

8           (2) Receiving no more than one courier visit per day; and

9           (3) Servicing less than six customers per day.

10           (b) A county may regulate activities of owners of home  
11 occupations that are disruptive to the surrounding neighborhood,  
12 or are a source of unreasonable noise or noxious fumes.

13           For the purposes of this section, "home occupation" means a  
14 business operated from a home by the owner occupant of a  
15 residential dwelling."

16           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
