
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOME OCCUPATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§46- Home occupation. (a) Notwithstanding any law to
5 the contrary, the owner of a home occupation may:

6 (1) Employ up to two non-occupant, non-family member
7 employees;

8 (2) Receive one courier visit per day, excluding
9 deliveries by the United States Postal Service; and

10 (3) Service up to five customers per day.

11 (b) A county may regulate activities of owners of home
12 occupations that are disruptive to the surrounding neighborhood,
13 or are a source of unreasonable noise or noxious fumes.

14 (c) For the purposes of this section, "home occupation"
15 means a business operated from a residential dwelling by the
16 owner-occupant of the residential dwelling."

17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
