
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 for capital improvement projects for the forty-sixth
3 representative district.

4 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
5 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
6 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
7 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010:

8 1. To be expended by the department of transportation:

9 A. North shore, Oahu

10 Plans, design, equipment, and construction of street
11 lights from Crawford Home to the entrance of the
12 Turtle Bay Resort.

13 Total funding \$ 750,000

14 2. To be expended by the department of education:

15 A. Waialua high and intermediate school, Oahu

16 Plans, design, equipment, and construction for
17 renovations and upgrades to the science, technology,



1 engineering, and mathematics learning center as
2 support for the robotics program.

3 Total funding \$ 750,000

4 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
6 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
