
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
42ND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010:

5 1. To be expended by the department of education:

6 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
8 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 are appropriated or
11 authorized, as the case may be, from moneys in the treasury
12 received from special funds and the general obligation bond fund
13 to finance the following project on Oahu. The letter symbols
14 used after the specific project appropriations indicate the
15 source of financing and have the following meaning: (B) special
16 funds, (C) general obligation bond fund.

17 University of Hawaii West Oahu campus, Oahu
18 Development of a West Oahu campus. \$100,000,000 (B)
19 \$35,000,000 (C)

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended, and the bonds
21 authorized shall be issued, by the University of Hawaii for the
22 purposes of this section. Any unexpended or unencumbered



1 balance of any appropriation made by this section as of the
2 close of business on June 30, 2011, shall lapse into the fund
3 from which appropriated. Any unissued balance of any
4 authorization made by this section as of the close of business
5 on June 30, 2011, shall lapse.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
