
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
3 "§8-11 Children and Youth Day and Month. The first Sunday
4 in October shall be known and designated as "Children and Youth
5 Day", and the entire month of October shall be known and
6 designated as "Children and Youth Month". Public events to
7 celebrate Children and Youth Day shall be held on the grounds of
8 the state capitol on the first Sunday in October, unless
9 otherwise determined by the Children and Youth Day Planning
10 Committee. This day and month are not and shall not be
11 construed to be state holidays."

12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
