## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER PROGRAM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 342G-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending the definition of "deposit beverage" to read  
3 as follows:

4           ""Deposit beverage" means beer, ale, or other drink  
5 produced by fermenting malt, hard spirits, mixed spirits, wine,  
6 mixed wine, tea and coffee drinks regardless of dairy-derived  
7 product content, soda, or noncarbonated water, and all  
8 nonalcoholic drinks in liquid form and intended for internal  
9 human consumption that is contained in a deposit beverage  
10 container."

11           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

12           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
