# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INTERMEDIATE APPELLATE COURT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Act 148, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is  
2 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:

3           "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval  
4 and shall be repealed on June 30, [~~2010.~~] 2012."

5           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on December 21,  
8 2058.

Extends intermediate appellate court judges' express authority to subpoena witnesses, compel the production of evidence, and administer oaths. Effective December 21, 2058. (HB1992 HD1)
