
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-1101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The purposes of community colleges shall be to
4 provide:

5 (1) Two-year college transfer and general education
6 programs;

7 (2) Two- and four-year career and technical education
8 programs;

9 (3) Semiprofessional, career and technical, and continuing
10 education programs; [and]

11 (4) The four-year educational programs offered pursuant to
12 section 304A-102; and

13 ~~[-(4)]~~ (5) Such other educational programs and services as
14 may be appropriate to such institutions."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
