RELATING TO COURT REPORTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 606, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:


4 "§606- Certified shorthand reporter; administration of
5 oaths or affirmations. Every certified shorthand reporter has
6 the power to administer oaths or affirmations and may perform
7 the duties of the deposition officer pursuant to rule 28(a) of
8 the Hawaii rules of civil procedure, relating to persons before
9 whom depositions may be taken."

10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
