
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 147-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "agricultural commodity"
3 to read as follows:

4 "Agricultural commodity" means fresh fruits and fresh
5 vegetables of every kind and character, whether or not frozen or
6 packed in ice, whether produced in the State or imported, nuts,
7 and coffee, whether cherry or parchment, or green beans, which
8 have been produced in the State, [and] raw unprocessed honey,
9 whether produced in the State or imported[-], and any animal
10 included in section 142-49 or its carcass or meat, whether
11 produced in the State or imported."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
