
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to statutorily
2 implement, upon its ratification, the constitutional amendment
3 to article X, section 3, of the Hawaii constitution, that
4 removes reference to the superintendent of education as a
5 position appointed by the board of education. Instead, the
6 legislature finds that the superintendent of education should be
7 appointed by the governor, upon the advice and consent of the
8 senate.

9 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:

11 "(a) There shall be a principal executive department to be
12 known as the department of education, which shall be headed by
13 an elected policy-making board to be known as the board of
14 education. The board shall have power in accordance with law to
15 formulate statewide educational policy, adopt student
16 performance standards and assessment models, and monitor school

3 (b) [~~The board shall appoint, and may remove, the~~

8 ~~(2) May be appointed for a term of up to four years; and~~

9 ~~(3) May be terminated only for cause.] There shall be a~~


10 superintendent of education who shall be the chief
11 executive officer of the public school system. The
12 superintendent shall be nominated and, by and with the
13 advice and consent of the senate, appointed by the
14 governor for a term to expire at the end of the term
15 for which the governor was elected. The
16 superintendent may be appointed without regard to the
17 state residency provisions of section 78-1. A vacancy
18 occurring during a term shall be filled for the
19 unexpired balance of the term, subject to the
20 provisions of Article V, section 6 of the Constitution
21 of the State. The governor may remove the
22 superintendent from office at any time."



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
4 and upon compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the
5 Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
