
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2010-2011
5 for capital improvement projects for the first representative
6 district, as follows:

7 1. Haaheo school, Hawaii

8 A. Plans, design, and construction for
9 pedestrian safety improvement.

10 Install sidewalk along Haaheo road that
11 leads to the school.

1 the appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the
2 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as
3 of that date."

4 SECTION 3. Act 158, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, section
5 5, is amended by amending Item 127.01 to read as follows:

31 item 89 of the Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, as amended by Act
32 162, section 73(4) of the Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, shall not



1 lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
 2 appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the
 3 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as
 4 of that date."

5 SECTION 5. Act 162, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, section
 6 62, is amended as follows:

28 SECTION 6. The appropriation made for the capital
 29 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 30 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is



1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 7. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
4 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
5 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
6 follows:

7 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 3 shall be
8 expended by the department of education;

9 (2) The sums appropriated by items 4 through 6 shall be
10 expended by the department of agriculture;

11 (3) The sums appropriated in items 7 through 8 shall be
12 expended by the Hawaii health systems corporation;

13 (4) The sums appropriated in items 9 through 10 shall be
14 expended by the department of Hawaiian home lands;

15 (5) The sums appropriated in items 11 through 12 shall be
16 expended by the department of land and natural
17 resources;

18 (6) The sums appropriated in item 13 shall be expended by
19 the department of transportation;

20 (7) The sums appropriated in item 14 shall be expended by
21 the University of Hawaii;



- 1 (8) The sums appropriated in item 15 shall be expended by
- 2 the county of Hawaii;
- 3 (9) The sums appropriated in item 16 shall be expended by
- 4 the county of Hawaii, department of public works; and
- 5 (10) The sums appropriated in items 17 through 19 shall be
- 6 expended by the county of Hawaii, department of water
- 7 supply.

8 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
