
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SALARIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 85, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is amended
2 by amending subsections (a) and (b) of section 2 to read as
3 follows:

4 "(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary and
5 notwithstanding the recommendations of the commission on
6 salaries for salary increases, beginning July 1, [~~2009,~~] 2010,
7 and until June 30, 2011, the annual salaries of the governor,
8 the lieutenant governor, the justices and judges of all state
9 courts, the administrative director of the State or an
10 equivalent position, and the department heads or executive
11 officers and the deputies or assistants to the department heads
12 or executive officers of the departments of:

- 13 (1) Accounting and general services;
14 (2) Agriculture;
15 (3) The attorney general;
16 (4) Budget and finance;
17 (5) Business, economic development, and tourism;
18 (6) Commerce and consumer affairs;



1 (7) Defense;

2 (8) Hawaiian home lands;

3 (9) Health;

4 (10) Human resources development;

5 (11) Human services;

6 (12) Labor and industrial relations;

7 (13) Land and natural resources;

8 (14) Public safety;

9 (15) Taxation; and

10 (16) Transportation,

11 shall be reduced by [~~five~~] 8.07 per cent from what the salary is

12 as of June 30, 2009, and shall remain at that salary rate until

13 June 30, 2011; provided that on July 1, 2011, the salaries of

14 these positions shall be restored to the level [~~they~~] that each

15 salary would have been on July 1, 2009, without the salary

16 decrease under this Act; provided further that the

17 recommendations of the commission on salaries for salary.

18 increases for these positions effective July 1, 2012, shall

19 become effective on that date in accordance with the,

20 recommendations.

21 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary and

22 notwithstanding the recommendations of the commission on

7 without the salary decrease under this Act; provided further
8 that the recommendations of the commission on salaries for
9 salary increases for legislators effective January 1, 2012,
10 shall become effective on that date in accordance with the
11 recommendations."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
